BOTHWELL HOSPICE TO HOST COMMUNITY MEMORIAL SERVICE

The public is invited to a community memorial service to remember loved ones who have died.

The 16th annual Community Memorial Service, themed “A Time to Remember,” will be at 10 a.m., June 25, at the Hospice Memory Kiosk, located in front of Bothwell Regional Health Center on the west side of the main parking lot.

The event is free and open to the public.

“This is a community event,” said Connie Tinsley, hospice bereavement coordinator. “It’s not just for families and friends of hospice patients.”

The event gives people the opportunity to honor and memorialize others who have died. Anyone can share a story, memory or poem about their loved one.

“It’s a special time that people can set aside to be together and remember a loved one they have lost,” Tinsley said.

Activities, such as attending the memorial service or planting a tree in memory of a loved one, are important in the grieving process.

“It’s important to take the grief outside of ourselves, and not keep it inside,” Tinsley said. “It’s one more way to validate that we have not forgotten that person we love.”
