NEW PATHOLOGIST ANNOUNCED AT BOTHWELL

Dr. Robert Littlejohn has been named the new pathologist in the laboratory at Bothwell Regional Health Center.

Dr. Littlejohn has been associated with Boyce & Bynum Laboratories since 2001. The health center contracts with Boyce & Bynum for pathology services. He earned his medical degree from the University of Missouri-Kansas City School of Medicine and completed residencies at the University of Oklahoma Health Sciences Center in Oklahoma City, Truman Medical Center/University of Missouri-Kansas City School of Medicine, and Pitt County Memorial Hospital/East Carolina University School of Medicine in Greenville. He also completed a fellowship in surgical pathology at Pitt County Memorial Hospital/East Carolina University.

Dr. Littlejohn was working at the hospital in Oklahoma City at the time of the bombing of the Alfred P. Murrah Federal Building in 1995. He is board certified by the American Board of Pathology. Dr. Littlejohn replaces Dr. Dennis Johnson, who recently retired after 13 years at Bothwell.
