BOTHWELL FOUNDATION OFFERS SCHOLARSHIP

The Bothwell Regional Health Center Foundation is seeking applicants for its Medical Careers scholarship.

“The Bothwell Foundation encourages area students to pursue health-related careers and return to this area to meet health-care needs right here at home,” said Lisa Church, executive director of the foundation and communications. “The Foundation’s Medical Careers Scholarship rewards high-achieving students and helps them with the expenses of post-secondary education.”

Applicants must meet the following criteria:

- U.S. citizen and a resident of the Bothwell Regional Health Center market area, roughly defined as a 40-mile radius of Sedalia;
- Successful completion of a high school education or General Educational Development (GED);
- Pursuing post-secondary education in a health-care related area of study;
- Accepted into an accredited post-secondary educational institution and enrolled in a health-related course of study.

The Bothwell Regional Health Center Foundation awards this \$500 scholarship annually, based on the availability of funds. Applicants may be asked to interview with the scholarship committee.

The deadline for applications is April 5. Applications will be available through high school guidance offices or by calling the Bothwell Foundation at 660-826-6263.

Bothwell Regional Health Center Foundation was formed in 2005 to develop private resources to improve health-care services for the community. It is overseen by a board of directors comprised of community leaders in Pettis and Benton counties.
