Ultrasound imaging, also known as sonography, uses high-frequency sound waves to produce images of internal body parts to help physicians diagnose illness, injury or other medical problems. Bothwell's ultrasound provides multi-dimensional imaging.

Most insurance, self-pay and Medicare and Medicaid assignment are accepted.

The ACR gold seal of accreditation represents the highest level of image quality and patient safety. The reaccreditation for Bothwell's Diagnostic Ultrasound Department runs through April 2017.
