## ROLLINGS ELECTED CHAIRMAN OF BOTHWELL BOARD OF TRUSTEES

SEDALIA – Rob Rollings was elected chairman of the Bothwell Regional Health Center Board of Trustees at its annual meeting.



Rollings, founder and president of the Sedalia-based Robert Rollings Architects, has served on the board of trustees since June 2007. He replaces Steve Biermann, who served two terms as chairman. Biermann remains a member of the board.

Steve Cain was elected vice chair, and Glen Nelson was elected secretary. Cain, general manager for PrintLynx in Sedalia, joined the health center board in 2007. Nelson, from Lincoln, retired from Pacific Bell Telephone and was appointed to the board of trustees in 2008.

Former board member Joe Bode stepped down after four years on the board. John Fritz, Sedalia, has been appointed by Mayor Elaine Horn as a new member of the board. A native to Sedalia and former city councilman, Fritz serves as the community relations chairman of the Sedalia Pettis County EMS Committee and as treasurer of the committee to form the Pettis County Ambulance District.



Officers are elected for two-year terms. The Bothwell Board of Trustees meets at 6 p.m. on the fourth Tuesday of each month at Bothwell Regional Health Center.
