BIERMANN ELECTED CHAIRMAN OF BOTHWELL BOARD OF TRUSTEES

SEDALIA – Steve Biermann was elected chairman of the Bothwell Regional Health Center Board of Trustees at its recent annual meeting.

Biermann, who retired as store director of the Wal-Mart SuperCenter in Sedalia in 2007, has served on the board of trustees since June 2004. He replaces David Lake, who served two terms as chairman. Lake remains a member of the board and also joins the board of the Bothwell Regional Health Center Foundation.

Joe Bode was elected vice chair, and Robert Rollings was elected secretary. Bode retired as president of Third National Bank in Sedalia and was appointed to the board of trustees in June 2007. Rollings, founder and president of the Sedalia-based Robert Rollings Architects, also joined the health center board in June 2007.

Officers are elected for one-year terms. The Bothwell Board of Trustees meets at 6 p.m. on the fourth Tuesday of each month at Bothwell Regional Health Center.

The board of trustees also honored Jack Robinson, who retired from the board following 16 years of service. Robinson, who was appointed in 1993 by then-Mayor Jane Gray, served multiple terms as vice chair and was a charter member of the Bothwell Regional Health Center Foundation Board of Directors.
