BOTHWELL MEDICAL STAFF ELECTS LEADERSHIP *Doak to Serve Third Term as Chief of Staff*

SEDALIA - Dr. Gregory Doak was re-elected to a third two-year term as Chief of Staff for Bothwell Regional Health Center during recent medical staff elections.
